

CMS HONOR SOCIETY

Purpose: To recognize excellence in academics, behavior, and character in graduating eighth grade students from Crestwood Middle School.

Eligibility: To be eligible for the Crestwood Middle School Honor Society a student must meet the following criteria:

- (1) The student must have a B+ average when averaged over the sixth, seventh and eighth grade years with no D's or F's in any subject as the final overall grade for the class.
- (2) The student must complete 6 service hours/year for a total of 18 service hours over the course of sixth, seventh, and eighth grades.
Note: Students must complete their hours from the list of approved service hour opportunities or have their service hour opportunity approved ahead of time by their teacher if it is not on the approved list. All hours must be logged on the appropriate "Service Hour Log Sheet", signed by the supervisor of the service hour opportunity, and submitted to the students teacher (one teacher/team will be identified as the point person for this).
- (3) The student must demonstrate appropriate school conduct over these three years, as determined by the school administration and teachers. Students deemed to have conduct not becoming of a member of the CMS Honor Society will be excluded.

Induction: There will be a special induction ceremony at the Eighth Grade Awards Night

Parent/Guardian(s) will be invited to attend.

In addition, a plaque bearing these students names will be hung in the hallway of the school.

- Modifications to the guidelines listed above will be made to determine the eligibility of students who have started at CMS after the beginning of their 6th grade year.
