Admission Requirements/ Application Procedure

Admission is granted through an online application process. The application is started by the student and completed by the home school counselor. Students who are 16 years of age, have earned at least 4 credits toward graduation, and who have attended 2 years of high school, are eligible to apply. Graduation Requirements

All Crestwood students attending Maplewood will graduate from Crestwood High School. Each student must complete all Crestwood graduation requirements with the following exceptions:

Length of Program

Maplewood is a two-year program. Students begin their selected program in their junior year and complete the program at the end of their senior year.

Suggested courses to be completed during the two years at Crestwood

It is suggested that students at Crestwood during their freshman and sophomore years complete two credits of each of the following: English, math, science and social studies. It is also suggested that students complete one-half credit of health and physical education. Students who have not completed the above at Crestwood will talk to both the Crestwood counselor and the Maplewood counselor to ensure that they have a plan as to how they will complete graduation requirements. Students will be able to apply for educational options to earn necessary credits to graduate.

Extracurricular Activities

Students who attend Maplewood Career Center are still students of their home schools. **Students from Crestwood are Crestwood students attending Maplewood.** These students may and are encouraged to attend and participate in all Crestwood after school, evening and weekend extracurricular activities, sports, clubs, dances, class trips etc.

College

Maplewood students will be able to attend college if they choose to do so. Students may actually be able to earn college credit for some of the programs that Maplewood Career Center offer.

Time Schedule

Classes start at Maplewood at 8:17 a.m., and end at 2:21 p.m. This schedule permits adequate travel time to and from Crestwood.

Transportation

Crestwood transports students by bus each school day to Maplewood and back.
