

SCHEDULE SELECTION

Registration for courses is one of the most important parts of a student's educational experience. Care and consideration must be given to selecting the schedule that will best prepare the student for post high school plans--whether to enter college, technical school, armed services, or seek employment.

COURSE SELECTIONS MUST BE FIRM Course selections are made based on recommendations of teachers and parents with input from students. The courses students select determine how many sections are needed of that particular class, the total master schedule, staffing, and the number of textbooks needed. **Therefore, schedule changes will not be made except when academic placement is inappropriate.**

The school administration reserves the right to cancel any course that has inadequate enrollment in order to efficiently use personnel and space to best serve our students. Courses and/or programs listed in this catalog may be cancelled and additional fees or pay to participate charges added if the school district has to make cutbacks due to insufficient funding.

COURSE LOAD

All freshmen, sophomores and juniors must be enrolled in at least SIX courses each semester. Seniors must be enrolled in at least FIVE classes. Please see "Extracurricular Eligibility" for the formula to determine credit equivalency on page 32.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Crestwood High School endeavors to meet the educational needs of all students. Appropriate courses for each student's special needs will be selected through a scheduling meeting with the special education teachers, parents, and the student. Critical to the course decisions will be the specifics as outlined in the student's I.E.P. Science courses will have a class fee.
